THINGS TO DO

Winter

STARGAZING McGee Creek State Park and the area surrounding it just outside of Atoka have fantastic night sky viewing. While this area is a level 3 on the Bortle scale, it is shielded from surrounding city light by the foothills of the Ouachita Mountains. This makes the stargazing wonderful. FISHING Bass and catfish are the big deals in Oklahoma. Several bass species, including largemouth, smallmouth and striped, can be found in Oklahoma. Anglers also love to fish, sometimes with their hands, for the blue, flathead and channel cats that live in the big rivers. Brown and rainbow trout, as well as walleye are also coveted species. HUNTING White-tailed deer, Eastern wild turkey, Bobwhite quail, wood ducks and mallards can all be found in Atoka County. Atoka Public Hunting Area covers 12,897 acres in Atoka County and is located 12 miles north of Atoka on Hwy 69. (ODWC)

Year Round

BIRD WATCHING With nearly 500 species of birds winging their way across Oklahoma, this land is prime bird watching territory. Migratory birds pass through Oklahoma twice a year along the central flyway of North America and birders will find surprises here such as Bald Eagles, American White Pelicans, Lesser Prairie Chickens and more.
